Mission Adventure

Basic Information

Who:

Incoming 9th graders to outgoing 12th graders

What:

A combination mission/adventure trip. After spending 2 days driving to the Blue Ridge Mountains, we will be working 3 ½ days doing construction for those in need in the Appalachia area. Then we will be spending 1 ½ days doing adventure activities such as hiking the Appalachian Trail, white water rafting, horseback riding, and paintball. We will take 2 days to drive back.

When:

June 11-19, 2016. Leaving early morning on Saturday the 11th. Returning by supper on the 19th.

Why:

To strengthen our faith in Christ. We will be living out our Christian call to serve the “least of these” with our construction work. The adventure part of the trip will focus on building strong friendships and reminding ourselves that we are “Enough.”

Where:

A night in Birmingham, Alabama on the way there. Our home base will be a camp in Blue Ridge, GA during the week. From there we will do our mission work, and they will coordinate our adventures. On the way home we will stay in a church near Biloxi, MS.

Cost:

\$500 \$50 deposit is due May 1. This includes travel, lodging and all equipment for the mission trip.

Additional money for 6 meals on the road and incidentals is not included in the price.
