TRINITY TOMORROW

As we turn to the second year of the Trinity Tomorrow Capital Campaign, we are proud to say that we have crossed the \$1,000,000 mark! Thank you to all the parishioners who have given so selflessly to make this happen. An update on the Child and Youth building will be coming in the next couple of weeks. Much has been going on behind the scenes!

ENERGY SAVINGS

Stewardship in action! Our initiative with Ideal Impact has been a huge success so far. Since March of this year, we have saved almost \$15,000 in energy costs. Last month, our total energy cost was about half of what it was for the same month of 2015.

RESERVE FUND DONATIONS

Our new roof and many repairs to our campus are complete. While our insurance paid a significant amount of the cost, Trinity needs to cover \$55,000 of the final bill. An anonymous donor has generously offered to match any and all donations to our reserve fund for these repairs to the Trinity campus. OPEN ENROLLMENT NOW AVAILABLE AT TRINITY EPISCOPAL DAY SCHOOL (TEDS)

TEDS is an excellent Episcopal faith based preschool that offers an academic focus with developmentally appropriate Math and Reading, enhanced by Science and Social Studies, and exceeds CISD benchmarks. Designed for 18 months to 5 year olds, the curriculum includes enrichment programs with Spanish, art, music, and movement, plus daily Chapel. The students-per-teacher ratio is small: 7 to 1 (pre-kinder, 4 year olds, and 3 year olds), 5 to 1 (2 year olds), 4 to 1 (18 months). Starting July 17, the 8:45 AM Adult Class will began a new series, *Bonhoeffer, The Life and Writing of Dietrich Bonhoeffer*. Bonhoeffer was a German Lutheran pastor, theologian, anti-Nazi dissident, and key founding member of the Confessing Church. Apart from his writings, he was known for his staunch resistance to the Nazis and later for being associated in a plot to assassinate Hitler. He was arrested and after a quick trial, was imprisoned, and later executed as the war was coming to an end. In this series we will be studying major themes from books by bestselling author Eric Metaxas. This class meets every Sunday in the Wesley Room for prayer, fellowship, and study.
