**TRINITY TOMORROW UPDATE**

Progress!

At the end of year one we are close to \$1.1 million in donations towards our three-year pledge of \$2.4 million for a Children and Youth building. This project was always intended to be debt free, so please continue to maintain your pledges or begin new ones.

Since our last update we have received a preliminary design plan from our architect that has allowed us to engage a construction company to estimate cost and timing of the project. That data is being assembled now and will be communicated in a more formal way in the next few weeks. This is not a detailed design, which is when we will get the final cost estimate as well as a rendering of the building exterior and interior.
