#### TRINITY TOMORROW UPDATE

Our capital campaign last year generated pledges of \$2.4 million, and we are on track to achieve that goal in the three-year commitment period. The generosity of the parish is very welcome, and this support is what drives the improvements we all want to see in our facilities. If you are new to the parish and missed the campaign, or did not pledge to a level that seems appropriate for you today, please contact any member of the Vestry and they would be glad to work with you.

The early pledge receipts have allowed us to fund creation of an initial building design, hiring of a contractor to work with us on further design and construction, do site surveys, and between now and the end of the year we will create detailed design drawings that allow an accurate construction cost estimate. The committee objective is to begin construction by the summer of next year. That puts the building dedication date in the spring of 2018.
