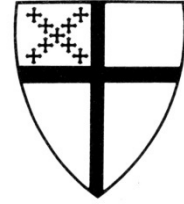

TRINITY TOMORROW UPDATE

The schematic design drawings (SDs) have been received from the architects, Merriman Holt Powell, and the project is currently on schedule. The contractor, Paradigm, is now requesting estimates from their individual sub-contractors, a process expected to take 3 weeks.

At the same time, the building committee, the architects, and Amanda Boling (TKC Coordinator) are reviewing the SDs for sufficient storage space and to confirm they are compliant with childcare licensing requirements.

Larry Martz confirmed that Trinity Tomorrow pledges stand at \$2.9 million, with \$1.45 million received and \$1.232 million in the bank. Thank you to all those supporting the new Trinity Children's Building both financially and spiritually. We will continue to update the parish as we make further progress. NEW ASSISTANT BISHOP NAMED TO THE DIOCESE OF TEXAS

The Rt. Rev. Hector Monterroso will join the Diocese of Texas on July 1, 2017 as Assistant Bishop. Bishop Monterroso will continue to strengthen the growth in both Hispanic congregations as well as new missional communities and church plants. Additionally, Bishop Monterroso will work to identify vocational leaders within the Hispanic congregations. He will be added to the prayers of the people in July.
