TRINITY TOMORROW UPDATE

We have bricks and mortar! Hallelujah!

The Trinity Tomorrow Steering Committee met for their regular monthly meeting on Friday, July 6, 2018. During the meeting it was announced that the Children's Ministry building is 61-62% complete with 70% of the drywall installed. A walk-through of the space will be scheduled for parishioners as soon as Paradigm Construction deems it safe, anticipated before the end of July. Additionally, 73% of pledge commitments have been received. The receipt of the remaining 27% of pledge commitments will ensure the building completion with no additional debt. Building completion remains on schedule for November 17, 2018, with the certificate of occupancy anticipated for December.
