TRINITY TOMORROW UPDATE: TOUR THE NEW CHILDREN'S MINISTRY BUILDING

The Trinity Tomorrow Steering Committee met for their regular monthly meeting on Friday, July 6, 2018. During the meeting it was announced that the Children's Ministry building is 61-62% complete with 70% of the drywall installed. Additionally, 73% of pledge commitments have been received. The receipt of the remaining 27% of pledge commitments will ensure the building completion with no additional debt. Building completion remains on schedule for November 17, 2018, with the certificate of occupancy anticipated for December. The new building will be available for tours on Sunday, July 29, after the 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. services. Come and see what the future of Trinity looks like!
