ADOPT A ROOM IN THE CHILDREN'S MINISTRY BUILDING

With the new building more than 90% complete, we are working on furnishings for the classrooms with an "Adopt-a-Room" campaign. This is a sponsorship program parishioners and church ministries help fund the furnishings for the six classrooms in the building. These classrooms will for TKC weekday program use, but also for our other children's ministries such as Jr. Daughters, Jr. Brothers, TNT, Sunday school, Children's Chapel here at Trinity. This building will be used nearly every day of the week.

Groups can choose to adopt a whole classroom, half a classroom or just a piece of furniture. A ministry may even choose to combine efforts with another group. The sponsors will have a plaque engraved with their name or ministry group and it will be hung in the new children's building. This is a great way to honor a family member, a loved one, or even a child who will get to be a part of this incredible facility.
